

EXCURSIONS around the

Ferienregion St. Johann in Tirol Oberndorf - Kirchdorf - Erpfendorf

Rattenberg → 50 km
The smallest town in Austria with castle ruins, late Gothic parish church, monastery church, Augustine museum. Famous for its glass production, magical world of glass with multimedia show.

Kramsach Tyrolean farmhouse museum
The largest open air museum in Tyrol, covering an area of 8 hectares. Exhibits the most important styles of Tyrolean farms and farmhouses including furniture and appliances.



Kufstein → 28 km
Old town with historical houses, fortress with "Heldenorgel" (organ honouring those who died in both world wars), home and fortress museum, the Riedel Glass company "Sinnfonie" museum with glass-blowing demonstration, Kufstein Inn shopping, stud farm Fohlenhof Ebbs



Innsbruck → 90 km

The provincial capital of Tyrol. It's Golden Roof is a resplendent late Gothic alcove with copper shingles and was built around 1500 in the time of Maximilian.

Sights: Imperial Palace, Imperial Church, City Tower, Alpine Zoo, Triumphal Arch, Bergisel Ski Jump, Ambras Castle



Wattens → 76 km
Swarovski Crystal Worlds

The dazzling subterranean experience consists of a collection of chambers of wonder, full of fantasy and set around the subject of crystal. Awaiting you inside is the largest as well as the smallest crystal in the world, a wall made from 12 tonnes of crystals and rooms which will captivate you with their lighting effects, sounds and aromas.

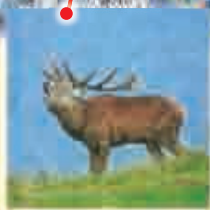


Schwaz → 65 km
Silver mines
Diving into the unique world of silver and copper mining 500 years ago, 800 metres deep in the mountain.

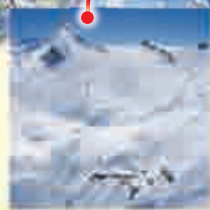


Krimml Falls → 53 km
The water wonderland of Krimml, fascinating water adventure to the source of the Krimml waterfalls in the Hohe Tauern national park.

Deer park Tirol - Aurach → 15 km
Wander around and relax in unspoiled nature and amongst approx. 200 animals in Tyrol's largest outdoor enclosure, feeding time at 2.30 pm.



Kitzsteinhorn Kaprun → 66 km
Three gondolas until 3029m will take you into a true glacier and panorama adventure: Panorama terraces, panorama tunnel, ice arena with snow caves, save path over the glacier.



Großglockner High Alpine Road
The most famous of all alpine roads ends before the highest mountain and the largest glacier in Austria, the Großglockner (3,798 m) and the Pasterze. Experience of nature at the Großglockner High Alpine Road: Game & Adventure Park Ferleiten



St. Jakob i.H. → 12 km
Adventure park and family land. Fun and games the whole day long with an exciting mixture of action and lively amusements



St. Martin near Lofer → 28 km
Lamprecht's cave, one of the largest cave systems in Europe, developed show-caves section for visitors with stunning and easily manageable footpaths.

Salzburg → 70 km
The largest, completely preserved castle in central Europe dating back to the 11th century, house where Mozart was born and lived, "Haus der Natur" (House of Nature), Hellbrunn Palace and fountains, Hellbrunn zoo



Berchtesgaden → 70 km
All the year round boat trips on the lake "Königssee" or with the gondola "Jennerbahn" into the national park. Salt mine Berchtesgaden - the wonderful world of "White Gold", the origin of the salt and the extraction of the raw material brine.



Chiemsee lake → 55 km
The largest lake in Bavaria, Herrenchiemsee island with fairytale castle King Ludwig II and "Fraueninsel" with Benedictine convent
